

Child Admission Policy

Sports clubs and associations and members of the public use Shoreline Sports Park facilities. Each area of the Park differs slightly with aspects of admission. The clubs and associations that use our facilities may have their own specific admissions policy. No child is refused admission due to their sporting ability, ethnicity, religious beliefs or gender.

Astro Turf Pitches	- A responsible person over the age of 16 years must accompany any	
Basketball Court	child under the age of 10 years.	
Tennis Courts	- Payment for court use must be made at Reception prior to use.	
Playground	- The playground is open to parents and children under the age of 13	
	years.	
	- Children under the age of 8 are to be supervised by an appropriate	
	adult	
Athletic Track	- A responsible person over the age of 16 years must accompany any	
	child under the age of 10 years.	
	- Children over the age of 10 are permitted onto the athletics track	
	unsupervised but are to be advised of avoiding any obstacles.	
	- In order to be admitted to the track, the child must sign in at	
	reception and pay the appropriate fee.	
Skate Park	- Only children over the age of 10 years are permitted in the Skate	
	Park. This is due to insurance reasons.	
	- In order to be admitted, the child must have a helmet.	
	- There is no admittance to the park when it is wet; due to health and	
	safety/insurance criteria.	
	- Admittance to the park may be limited due to overcrowding.	
	- Management have the right to refuse admission to the skate park	
	based on previous behaviour.	
	- Minimum of 4-6 people are required for floodlights to be turned on	
	in the evenings. After 8pm the lights will be turned on if needed.	
Rock Walls	- Rock Walls are open to children over the age of 6 years.	
	- Children may not be admitted to the rock walls due to weather	
	conditions such as rain and ice.

Birthday Parties	- There is to be no more than 15 children in each group.

	- Archery- Children must be over 8 years of age to participate and the	
	group is restricted to 10.
